People with disability are at the centre, with the outcomes, indicators, and data collection methods developed based on what is both meaningful and practical



Work with stakeholders across the ecosystem to develop a common language which reflects the various levers required to create good outcomes for people with disability



A consistent underlying architecture, with flexibility in emphasis, measurement and data collection for different participants and different service types



Data collection tools and processes are clear, relatively simple, and able to be used in an integrated and efficient way within the context of service delivery, within an appropriate privacy and consent framework



Provides sufficient information to guide and influence decision making by diverse stakeholders to influence and improve outcomes for people with disability
